The Defendant is sentenced to

Life in prison at hard labor on count 1 concurrently.

- 20 years hard labor on count 2 concurrently.
- 10 years hard labor on count 3 concurrently.

As to count 1, the Court sentenced the Defendant to imprisonment at hard labor for a term of his life with all counts running concurrently with each other. Defendant is given credit for time served pursuant to C.Cr.P. 880 from date of initial arrest until today for each day defendant actually served. The Defendant is committed to the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections for execution of said sentence in conformity with L.S.A.-R.S. 15:824.

As to count 2, the Court sentenced the Defendant to imprisonment at hard labor for a term of 20 years with all counts running concurrently with each other. Defendant is given credit for time served pursuant to C.Cr.P. 880 from date of initial arrest until today for each day defendant actually served. The Defendant is committed to the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections for execution of said sentence in conformity with L.S.A.-R.S. 15:824.

As to count 3, the Court sentenced the Defendant to imprisonment at hard labor for a term of 10 years with all counts running concurrently with each other. Defendant is given credit for time served pursuant to C.Cr.P. 880 from date of initial arrest until today for each day defendant actually served. The Defendant is committed to the Louisiana Department of Public Safety and Corrections for execution of said sentence in conformity with L.S.A.-R.S. 15:824.

As to count 1, the sentence is to be served without the benefits of parole, probation, or suspension of sentence.

The Defense's objection to the sentence is noted for the record.

This conviction is designated by the court as a crime of violence on count (1) 14:30 MURDER/FIRST DEGREE.

The Court ordered that the above sentence is to run concurrently with all counts and any/all other sentence(s) that the Defendant is currently be serving.

The Court recommends any/all self help programs, drug treatment program(s), work release and/or re-entry program(s) that the Defendant may be eligible.

The Court informed the Defendant he/she has thirty (30) days from today's date to appeal this conviction, and two (2) years after judgement of conviction and sentence has become final to seek post-conviction relief.

The Defendant was remanded to the Jefferson Parish Prison to await transport to a Department of Corrections facility.
